and my will and desire is that all my movable Estate be sold at      be paid out of my estate Public Auction and that money for to pay the teacher for learning my four Grand Children V<sup>iz</sup> John Elizabeth Catharine and William Buddin and the remainder to equally divided among all my Grand Children but my three grand Children V<sup>iz</sup> Marry Nancy and Judeth Scott not to receive their part till they become of the age of eighteen years of age and I do make and ordain Thomas Buskirk and Barwell Evans my Executors to Execute and perform my will and I do
