I Bequeath and Dispose of in manner and form following.-----First I give and Bequeath to my well Beloved Daughter Sarah Reddick one Hundred and fifty acres of Land which was Granted To Richard Bur-bage and forty acres more Joining the Same tract being part of A tract of Land Granted to Thomas McKlevein to her and the Ifeue of her Body For Ever, if she has an Ifeue of her Body that lives to the age of twenty one years of age in order to take possefson of the Same if she should continue on the Said Land But if She Does Not continue on the Said land Then My Executors to lease or Rent the sd Tract of land During her life and the Money to be laid out in Charleston In such Clothing as she ^{MAY} chuse, and at her Death, if she hath no Ifeue. The said land to be sold and the money Equally Devived amongst the Rest of my Children. Likewise I give and Bequeath to my well Beloved Son Crifopher Garlington one Hundred and Sixty acres of Land lying on Cockdale Branch to him and his Heirs for Ever which said land was granted to Thomas McKlevein. and after my Debts is Paid all the Remainday of my Estate to be sold and the Money Equally Devived among five of my Children, Namely. Christopher Garlington, Jofeph Garlington, Elizabeth Foston, Ann Parfons and Hannah Chinners, which said Hannah Chinners part of legacy is to be laid out in Charleston in Such Clothing as sh may chuse,-----And I do hereby Con-stitute and Appoint my well Beloved Son Jofeph Garlington & Levi

ly Estate such as it pleased God to blefs me with in this life.
