In The Name of God Amen, I Christopher Garlington of Clarendon County Sumter District Being of Perfect mind and memory Make this my last will and Testament in manner and form following--First after my Departure from this Life I Desire my Body to be Decently Buried at the difcretion of my Executors And as touching my worldly Estate such as it pleased God to blefs me with in this life. I Bequeath and Dispose of in manner and form following.-----First I give and Bequeath to my well Beloved Daughter Sarah Reddick one Hundred and fifty acres of Land which was Granted To Richard Burbage and forty acres more Joining the Same tract being part of A tract of Land Granted to Thomas McKlevein to her and the Issue of her Body For Ever, if she has an Issue of her Body that lives to the age of twenty one years of age in order to take possession of the Same if she should continue on the Said Land But if She Does Not continue on the Said land Then My Executors to lease or Rent the sd Tract of land During her life and the Money to be laid out in Charleston In such Clothing as she ^{MAY} chuse, and at her Death, if she hath no Issue. The said land to be Sold and the money Equally Devided amongst the Rest of my Children. Likewise I give and Bequeath to my well Beloved Son Criftopher Garlington one Hundred and sixty acres of Land lying on Cuckelds Branch to him and his Heirs for Ever which said land was granted to Thomas McKlevein. and after my Debts is Paid all the Remaindag of my Estate to be sold and the Money Equally Devided among five of my Children, Namely. Christopher Garlington, Joseph Garlington, Elizabeth Poston, Ann Parsons and Hannah Chinnere, which said Hannah Chinnere part of legacy is to be laid out in Charleston in Such Clothing as sh may chuse,-----And I do hereby Constitute and Appoint my well Beloved Son Joseph Garlington & Levi
