In the name of God amen I Daniel McDonald do make declare and publish this my last will & Testament I give and bequeath to Susannah Rachel Frierson Conyers a negro girl named June. and in case she dies leaving no child alive at her death then the Said girl June is to go over to John Napoleon Frierson, and ~~his~~ his heirs and if the said Susannah Rachel Frierson Conyers should have child or children alive who should die without children before twenty one years of age then the said June is go over to said John Napoleon Frierson

The rest of my personal estate and all my real estate I give to John Napoleon Frierson and his heirs forever. I direct my lands. and real estate to be sold and all my perishable property, ( not negroes ) to be sold on payment of my debts, and the funds thereby realised after payment of debts to be visted in negroes or the money put out at interest for the benefit of Said John Napoleon Frierson at the option of my Executors and I do hereby appoint Major John Frierson & John I Frierson my executors hereby revoking all other wills this            Day of            Anno Domei 1819 -----
