

In the Name of God, Amen. I Daniel Rose of Sumterville of the State of S. Car a citizen of said State, & a Merchant being sick & weak in body but of sound mind memory & understanding, fer which I thank God- I do hereby make my will as follows.

First. I desire that all my debts be paid--

Secondly. I give and bequeath unto my wife Elizabeth Rose, a feather bed, bedstead & furniture, my gray horse, chair & harnes, a negro Girl named Darky Her increase, also the sum of one thousand Dollars (& also one hundred Dollars to purchase a chair & harnes for her to be purchased as soon as convenient)---payable in two years after my death if my estate will then permit, no interest before that time, the above in lieu ~~of~~ Dower & other claims. The above personal estate to be ^{inventoried} ~~inventoried~~ & appraised before delivered to her, which I direct to be immediately done, her receipt to be taken therefor, she not to be accountable for the same only in case of a deficiency to pay my debts.-----

Thirdly. I recommend my old & blind servant Billy to the care of my said wife, requesting her to take good care of him, and I do hereby direct that ~~if~~ the same be necessary that my executor expend on his support & clothing twenty Dollars yearly.-----

Fourthly. It is my will that my Child Henreitta Elizabeth Rose remain with my wife until my executor shall think proper to send her to ~~the~~ school, & that he do, pay her for the mentenance of my Child while it remains with my said wife, if so much be necessary the sum of one hundred Dollars per annum, besides doctors Bills, It is my wish that my child do have such an education as her capacity and property will permit of,-----

Fifthly. Should Major John Singleton my wife's father die before him & I become in right of my wife entitled to any of his estate. I do hereby renounce & relinquish all claim thereto in favor of my wife---

Sixthly. It is my will & desire that my executor do sell all my real estate, & all the rest of my personal estate not above mentioned--

On the following terms, the personal ~~in~~ one year credit, taking Bond

three years credit payable by equal annual

& personal security & a mortgage of the premises. That he do collect as fast as convenient the debts due me, & the proceeds of the property ordered to be sold, that out of the same the above legacy to my wife be paid, all my debts, the annual allowance for my said Servant, & that my child be supported & educated as above, until She becomes of age or marries--That all the rest & remainder of my estate after paying my debts, the legacy to my wife & the sum for the annual support of Billy. I give & bequeath unto my child Henrietta Elizabeth Rose, but should my child ~~marry~~ die under age, unmarried & without lawful issue, then ~~in~~ that case, It is my will that the interest that be made after such event be paid to my aged & beloved mother if alive during her life, after her death, The estate herein given to my child to be divided between my brothers & Sisters, & the children of any now or then deceased brothers or Sister giving to such children the share of their parent except my Sister Martha, to whom I only give & intend shall take half as much as my other brothers & Sisters as above.

Seventhly. It is my will that y executor do vest the proceeds of the sale of my estate, debts received above bequeathed to my child in bank stock, in the United States.

Lastly- Inominate John B Miller sole executor & Guardian also of my child during his life, that is to say until my child become of age, should he live so long, then her estate to be given up to her for her ^{Use} sole & separte but should he renounce his executorship under this my will, Then I nominate Hugh Fraser, ~~Thomas Mullady~~ Robert Bradford, John Anderson executors hereof-----In witness whereof I have hereunto set set my hand & seal, this thirteenth day of July A.D one thousand eight hundred and
