Codicil to Will Of David Anderson

Be it known unto all Man by these Fresents That I David Anderson of Medway in the State of Georgia, have made and declared that my last Will and Testament in Writing bearing date the 12th of April one Thousand seven hundred and highty four--- I the said David Anderson do marki by these Fresents, confirm and Ratify my said last Will and do give and Bequeath unto my Nephew John Anderson Four hundred and Forty Three acres of Land of the Tract of Land whereon he now lives; also I do give and bequeath unto my Mephew William Anderson Two hundred and fifty seven acres of Land on the supposed Barony to them and their heirs forever provided the abovesaid John Anderson Doth allow and permit his Mother Ann Anderson to live on any part of the said Land During her Life Time, and It is also my part and besire that my belovedwife Mary do live upon and enjoy that part of my land (lying and being in the State of Georgia) which is Bequesthed unto William Anderson During her Widowhood and I do a lso give and Bequeath unto my Nephew Joseph Anderson my Tract of Land on on/ Lynches Creek containing Two hundred acres to him and his heirs forever and my Will and meaning is that this Codicil or Schedule be esteemed and adjudged to be Fart with parcel of my said will and Tes tament, and that all Things therein contained and mentioned, be faithfully preformed in as full and emple Manner in every Respect, as if the same were so declared and set-down in my said Will, In witness whereof I the said David Anderson have hereunto set my hand and Seal, The 12th day of April 1784 Signed, Sealed, & pronoun ced and Declared in presence of
