Cotton fodder, also My grey Mare and all my hogs and heep I do also give and bequeath unto My Daughter Sarah Josseys heirs - two Cows and one Yearling also I give to my life Sarah and Son Drury all by household and Kitchen furniture. also give to My Son Burwell Boykin Ten dollars. also My Son John Boykin Ten dollars, also My daughter Mary Dority Ten dollars also to my Son Jonathan Boykin Ten dollars, all of which I wish my edministrator to nunctually Abserve. In Witness hereof I have hereunto Sett my hand and Seal This 28 December 1835.
