Fifth The Rest and Residue of my whole Estate not otherwise disposed of, I give and Bequeath unto my Sons Samuel Edgar Plowdon, William Plowdon, Miles Hampton Plowdon, Edward Ransom Plowdon, Gabriel Plowdon and My Daughters Mary Nelson Montgomery, Frances Elizabeth Plowdon and Hannah Plowdon Share and Share alike . - Sixthly & Lastly I do hereby Constitute, Nominate and Appoint my Sons Samuel Edgar Plowdon William Plowdon and Miles Hampton Plowdon as my Lawful Executors of this my Last Will and Testament. - Witnefs whereof I the Said Edward Plowdon have hereunto Subscribed my name, Affixed my Seal, and Declared, Pronounced and Published this my Last Will and Testament this Twenty Seventh day of December in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred Seventeen.
