Rembert. of of the State and District aforesaid Phisician: being in a low state of body but of perfect mind and memory, thanks be given unto God, calling into mind the mortality of my body, and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say principally and first of all, I give and recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God. that gave it and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian burial. at the discretion of my Executors, nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same by the mighty power of God.

And as touching such worldly Estate as it has pleased God to blefs me with in this life I give demise and dispose of in the following Manner,

First I give and bequeath unto my Brother Thomas Rembert. one hun-

dred dollars & I also give to my sister Amelia Lenoir one hundred dollars, & also to my sister Mary Ann Sylvester one hundred dollar and I further give and bequeath to each of my Brother Thomas Remberts three Sons James V. Rembert, Edward Rembert, and Thomas E Rembert, the sum of four hundred dollars, and I further give and bequeath to my Brother. James E. Rembert the balance of my estate Consisting as follows, (Viz) one Negroe woman named Sabel one other negroe woman named Cotto. and two boys John & Richard, also one Horse Saddle and bridle, together with all other articles appertaining to my Estate, Provided that the said James E, Rembert shall pay all the Lawfull debts which may Come against my estate, -And I do hereby Make Constitute and ordain. Thomas English, and Francis Kennedy the sole Executors of the last will and testament and I do utterly disallow revoke and disamnul all and every former testaments wills Legacies and bequeats and executors by me by me in any wise before named willed and bequeathed ratifying and

Confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament In th
