Beadstid and furniture) and also A tract of land lying on Douglass
Swamp called the Isaiah tract and all My stoak of horses Cattle
and hogs to be sold and after satisfying all My just debts the balance
to be divided into five parts equally for My Son Daniel Johnson
My son Isaiah Johnson Eligh Johnson Harper Johnson and Blaney
Johnson -

2 Item - All My personal property to be sold at publick Auction
and the Money divided between My daughters or the heirs of their
body My daughter Gatsy Harper Betsy Hourhand and Margaret Rinder -

3 Item The Bead and beadstid and furniture excepted I do will
and bequeath unto My son Blaney Johnson - Lastly I do hereby Nomi-
nate and appoint My well beloved Sons Harper and Blaney Johnson
My sole Executors to this My last will and testament - Revoking
and Disannulling all other wills Legacies and bequests whatsoever
declaring this and no other to be My last will and testament-
