ELI MCKINNEY

In the name of God Amen this sixth day of November one Thousand eight hundred and nineteen I Eli McKinney of Sumter District and State of South Carolina being Very weak in body but of sound and correct mind and memory blessed be God----- and doubting the time of my dissolution to be near At hand do Give and Recommend my soul to God My Body to be decently buried my worldly Estate to be disposed of as follows Viz I Give unto my Dearly beloved Mother one Negro Man named Jeffrey together with one cow and calf marked with a crop in one year and a horse in the other which I wish her to Receive at my death and I enjoy her Life time and at her Death I wish the above named Jeffrey and the Cow and the Increase thereof to goe to my brother William McKinney whom I Give to my brother William McKinney all the Moneys arising from the sale of my land which I have sold together a stock of hogs and the balance of my Cattle with a Feather Bed with its furniture and that he to enjoy them

Immediately after my death and it is my wish that my right in the same should be Equally divided between my Mother Mary Singletary and my brother William McKinney and I the said Eli McKinney do publish This as my last will and testament in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred nineteen and in the 43 year of the American Independence
