Carolina Sumter District Salers County being sick and weak of body but of perfect mind and Memory, calling to mind the mortality of my body, and knowing that it is appointed for all Once to die, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament, that is to say principally and first of all I give and Recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it,--and my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent christian burial at the discretion of my Executors; nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God--And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to blesse me with in this life I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner & form----My Will & Desire is that all my Estate Real and personally be Sold after my decease and the monies, thence arising to be applyed to the use and Advantages of my three Children Namely love Daniel, Hopkins Daniel and Derier Daniel for the purpose of raising and Educating them untill they are able to Labour for their own Support the Residue of the Mony to be kept at Interest until they arrive to Lawful age or marry then to be Equally Divided among them,---I do hereby constitute and appoint my Trusty friends Thomas Woodard and Nathan Hanks my sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament--And I do hereby utterly disannul and Revoke every former Will & Testament, ratifying & Confirming this and no other to be my last will & Testament.
