Viz) First Item. to my nephew Hamdon Bradley now living in the western Country I give and Bequeath the Sum of three Hundred Dollars to be paid to him ¹²twelve Months After my decease

In the Second place I give and bequeath to my my niece Sarah G. Fleming one bed bedstead and furniture. Third and and lastly after my just debts are paid I then leave and Bequeath unto my beloved Brother John Fleming the remainder of all my ^{consist-}ing Estate ^{negroes notes obligations &c. &c.} to his and to his heirs forever
