Item I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved Brothers John Gabriel Guignard the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to him and his heirs forever-----

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved Sister Margaret Horry a like sum of two hundred Dollars to her and her heirs forever-----

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved Nephew James L Guignard three negroes viz. Stephen Jerry and Jack to him and his heirs and assigns forever-----

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved neice Caroline Guignard a negro Fellow named Nella to her and her heirs for ever-----

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved nephew John Ivor and Benjamin G Ivor the Plantation whereon I now live to them and their heirs and assigns forever-----

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved neice Ann Mayrant my kitchen Furniture- Windsor Chaires and Dinning Tables

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved neice Ann M Chevis a negro Fellow named Primus a Bedstead Bed bedding and Chamber Furniture- also one Chest of Drawers and a Suit of Mourning to her and her heirs and assigns forever-----

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my grand neice Ann Ivor (daughter of John Ivor) a negro wench named Agnes and her two children together with her future increase to her and her heirs forever-----

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved nephew John Ivor the one half of the remainder of my negroes to him and his heirs or assigns forever-----

G. Ivor the other half of the remainder of my negroes In trust  
nevertheless and for the following intents and purposes that is  
to say in trust for the use benefit and behoof, as well for the  
children he now has, as for those which he may hereafter have to  
them and their theirs or Survivor or Survivors of them forever  
share and share alike-----

Item The Tract of Land I own near Stateburgh containing about  
thirty acres it is my will and desire should be sold by my Executor  
or Executors (should only one of them qualify) also my Plantation  
Tools, Waggon and all other personal property not herein before  
particularly mentioned, <sup>be</sup> sold in like manner the proceeds where-  
of to be appropriated in payment of my just Debts and Legacies  
and any overplus remaining after paying my debts and Legacies I  
give and bequeath to -----

• And lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my nephews James L  
Guignard and John Ivor Executors to this my last will and Testa-  
ment hereby revoking all others by me heretofore made declaring  
this and no other to be my last will and Testament-----

H Mayrant Devide and bequeath to him and his heirs forever. It is  
my will and desire that Simon be sold unto William Gaulding at a  
reasonable price. It is also my will and desire that Mellifont
