my death, be Sold endacredit of twelve months, and the money a-
rising from Such Sale to be applied towards the Schooling and
Maintenance of my Children and I also desire that my Executor
hereafter named Shall purchase a young Negro woman with the money
due me from Edward Plowden, and Hire out Said negroe untill my
youngest Child arrives to the age of twenty one years and then
said negroe to go to my son Hiram and his heirs forever, and her
Increase if any at that Time to be Equally Devided between my
other children then living Share and Share alike, to them and their
heirs for ever-----

Lastly I nominate Constiture and appoint My Friend John Hodge,
Executor to this my Laast Will and testament, In witness whereof
I have hereunto sett my hand and Seal this thirteenth day of July
Anno Domini 1809-----
