In the Name of God, Amen. I Elizabeth Singleton, of the Town of  
Anchaster in the County of Clarendon widow being in health and  
having sound and disposing mind & memory Praised be God for the  
same do make and declare this my last will and testament in manner  
& form following.

1<sup>st</sup> I give, devise and bequeath unto my Son Robert Singleton and  
the Heirs of his body Lawfully begotten the following Named  
Negroes together with their future issue & increas to wit Dick,  
Lucy, Henry-Ceasor and Young Antony:

Secondly-- I Give, devise, & bequeath unto my Son Sherwood James  
Singleton and to the heirs of his body Lawfully begotten the  
following Named Negroes together with their future issue & increas  
to wit Kelly-Peggy Sam-Paul and Barny; And in Case my Son Sherwood  
James Singleton shall happen to die without leaving issue of his  
body Lawfully begotten then & in that Case my will is that the  
Negroes & their future Issue & increas, above given to my Son  
Sherwood James Singleton shall to my Son Robert Singleton & the  
heirs of his body Lawfully begotten

3<sup>d</sup> I give devise & bequeath unto my Grand Children Elizabeth Jane  
Falconer Martha Falconer Nancy Falconer and William Joseph Fal-  
coner (the following named Negroes and to the heirs of their body  
Lawfully begotten the following Named Negroes with all their fu-  
ture issue & increas to wit--Nance-George, Asy-venus-Real-tience-  
Isaac-batty and Lydia to be equally divided between the above Men-  
tioned Grand Children, when the Eldest of the above Mentioned  
Grand Children shall Marry or arrive at the age of eighteen Years;  
And in case any of the above Mentioned Grand Children should happen  
to die without leaving issue of his, her or their bodys lawfully  
begotten then and in that Case his/her or their part or parts to be

3<sup>d</sup> I give devise & bequeath unto my Grand Children Elizabeth Jane Falconer Martha Falconer Nancy Falconer and William Joseph Falconer (the following named Negroes and to the heirs of their body Lawfully begotten the following Named Negroes with all their future issue & increas to wit--Nance-George, May-venus-Rea-attience Isaac-betty and Lydia to be Equally divided between the above Mentioned Grand Children, when the Eldest of the above Mentioned Grand Children shall Marry or arrive at the age of eighteen Years; And in case any of the above Mentioned Grand Children should happen to die without leaving issue of his, her or their bodys lawfully begotten then and in that Case his-her or their part or parts to be equally divided amongst the above Mentioned surviving Grand Children or Children to them and the heirs of their body Lawfully begotten and in case all the above Mentioned Grand Children should happen to die without leaving issue of their bodys lawfully begotten then & in that case my will is that the Negroes with all their future issue & increas that I gave to my Grand Children above
