White my son Robert R White & my Daughter Rachel McDonald White all my Household & kitchen furniture to be equally Devided amongst them Share & Share alike, to them & there Heirs forever) I give & bequeath to my children named as followers. David White Arther White, Naome Harvin, Elisabeth Fleglar, Ellener Nestles, Martha White & Susannah White, all the rest & residue of my personal Estate of what kind so ever I may be pofseised of or Intitled to at the Time of my Death, to be Equally Devided between them Share and Share alike to them and their Heirs forever I also Desire that my children unmarried shall remain on my plantation and have the use of it untill my youngest child arives to the age of twenty one years and no longer) Lastly I nominate appoint and constitate my sons William White and Robert R. and State aforesaid have made my last will and Testament bearing
date of the fifth day of august one thousand Eight hundred and
nine Which is hereunto Enaxed by Seals--wherein I gave and be-
queathed to my daughter Rachel McDonald White a certain tract of
land known by the name of the meeting house tract whick I pur-
chased from my Son Arthur White, but Since the time of making the
above Enaxed will I have altered my mind in the gift of the above
named tract of land and by these presents do declare that & only
that clause of my the above will to be null & void & of affect-
and in lieu thereof by these presents do hereby give and bequeath
the Said---Meeting house tract of land containing four hundred
and thirty four acres to my---Daughter Elizabeth Flaglers and
the heirs Issue of her body if any forever--but should she the
said Elizabeth Flaglers leave no such Issue or her issue die and
leave no Issue then in Eigher of those cases the above mentioned
tract of Land is to Return to her own Brothers and Sisters or their
lenial descendants vis--In witness whereof I have hereunto Set my
hands and Seal this tenth day of July one thousand Eight hundred
and ten and thirty--fifth year of Americas indepeny---Say 10th
