Considering the Uncertainty of this Mortal Life; But being of Sound and Perfect Mind, Memory and Understanding Blefssed be to God for the same; do make and Publish this my last Will and Testament in Manner and form Following) that is to say) 1st

That all my Just Debts and Funeral Charges be first paid, and that my Body be buried at the discretion of my Friends:-----

2nd I give and bequeath to my Wife Susanna Des,Champs, the use of a Negro Named Elcey during her natural life, and after her death I give the said Elcey with all her Future Issue and Increase to my Son George Sinclair Capers Des,Champs-I also give my Wife Susanna DesChamps Two Girls Named Martha and Lavinah;---I give her one Horse Named Fox, Chair and Harness, one Feather Bed, one Mattress, Bed Furniture, and Bedstead; all the Crockery ware, two small Trunks one large green Chest, and Fifty Dollars to be given her out of my Estate:-----

3rd I give and bequeath to my Son Lewis Miles Des,Champs, Hannah, Elcey, Wiley, and the one half of my Stock of Cattle, including those I promis'd him in my life time:-----

4th I give and bequeath to my Son George Sinclair Capers Des,Champs my Plantation whereon I now live; I also give my Son Sinclair Lydia Sacarissa Purrian Dick and Hardtimes; one Dark Bay Horse, one Grey Mare, two Saddles and Bridles, one half of my Stock of Cattle, one shot gun, one Horse Cart, one hand Crust Mill, ploughs, Plantation--Tools, all my Stock of Hogs, Goats, and Sheep, all my Household, and Kitchen Furniture, Except what I have given as aforesaid; I also give my ^{Son} Sinclair all the profits of the Crop now growing and the use of the Negroes until the first day of January Next, he is to pay Samuel Rembert his demand for this Plantation purchased of him, My Wife Susanna Des,Champs, and my Son Lewis Miles Des,Champs, I do clear and acquit, of--having any Moneys to pay Samuel Rembert out of their Part; I give all my Books to my Son Sinclair: I lastly Nominate and appoint my Wife Susanna Des,Champs Executor, and my Son George Sinclair Capers Des,Champs executor of this my last Will

and Testament; herby Revoking all former Wills by me Made:-----
