In The Name of God Amen The Twenty Third day of May anno Domini One Thousand Eight Hundred and six, I George Cater Senr of State of South Carolina and District of Sumter being Weak in Body but of good and perfect memory Thanks be given unto God, Therefore willing to call to mind the mortality of the Body, and Expecting the time of my dissolution to be near at hand I do make and ordain this my last will and Testament and first of all I give and recomend my soul to the hands of God who gave it and for my Body I recomend it to the earth to be Buried in a Christian Like and decent Manner at the Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the General resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God.--- and as Touching such worldly Estate where with it hath pleased God to Bless me in this Life, I give Bequeath and Dispose of the same in the following manner and form, Imprints, I give and Bequeath to my Loveing wife Judith all my personal property during her natural life, and at her death to be sold, and Equally divided Between my sons, Daniel and Burwell and my daughter Elizabeth

Item I give and Bequeath to my son William five shillings to be paid ~~one year after my death~~

Item I give an Bequeath to my son George five shillings to be paid one year after my Death--Item I give unto my daughter Ann Crater five shillings to be paid twelve months after my death, Item I give and Bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Teague five shillings to be paid One year after my Death

Item I give and Bequeath unto my ~~Daughter~~ Frances Knighton five shillings to be paid One year after my death, Item I give and Bequeath to my son John five shillings to be paid one year after my death- Item I give and Bequeath to my son Obed five shillings to be paid one year after my death

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughesh Frances Knighton five shillings to be paid One year after my death, Item I give and Bequeath to my son John five shillings to be paid one year after my death- Item I give and Bequeath to my son Obed five shillings to be paid one year after my death

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Daniel ~~One Hundred and Niney~~ Acres of Land out of the tract I now Live on Item I give and Bequeath to my son Burwell ~~fourty~~ Acres of Land being part of a tract which Obed Cater Lives on also One Hundred and Ten Acres of the tract I now live on to Join the before mentioned fourty Acres- Item I give my wife the use of the plantation whereon I Live her Life time- I Like wife make, constitute and appoint William Cater and
