HENRY DURANT

The Last Will of Henry Durant, State of Sumter District Salem
County, South Carolina;

Declared by him, by word or mouth the Eighth Day of January 1805,
A few minutes previous to his Death, at his own House, Call,d
Upon us whose Names are Underwritten to Evidence the Method in
which he wifh,d his Estate to be divided which are as follows,
Viz.

The Perfonal Property, that I have already give to my Oldest
Children, I allow to them- Who are to remit the sum of five
hundred Dollars to my Wife & younger Children, in Confequence of
Land give to them and also all my Perfonal Property now in my
Pofsefsion, to be Equally Divided, between my wife & younger Child
ren.

These were the words spoken by the said Henry Durant, Deceased,
in the prefence of us whose Names are wunderwritten, As Evidence
for the Due Executors thereof-----
