this my last will and testament in manner and form following -

Estate real and personal viz That is to say five negroes three
Head of Horses ~~5 yoke of Cattle~~ and Hogs and Also the plantation
or Lands where I now live with all and singular, the premises
there on with all the profits Arising therefrom for her use and
Support during the natural term of Her life also the Education
maintenance and Support of my Daughter Isabella. White shall be
taken out of the profits of my Estate, Also I Give devise and be-
queath to my Beloved Daughter Isabella White aforesaid, (at the
death of my wife Margaret,) the whole of my Estate left my wife
During the natural term of her life with the Lands & negroes
Stocks of Horses Cattle & Hogs with my House Hold and Kitchen
Furniture, Also I Give and devise If my Daughter Isabella, should
die without Issue, at the of the last Surviving my wife or Daughter
If ~~any~~ mentioned above, shall be Equally Divided between my
Brother William Whites son Henry, & Brother Jesse - Whites son
Henry equally between them, and I do nominate constitute and ap-
point Jesse White and William Gerald to be my Executors of this
my last will and testament revoking all others heretofore made
or made by me ^{I Henry White have Revoked} Therefore, set my Hand And Seal this Twenty Seventh
day of September in the year of Our Lord One thousand Eight Hun-
dred and five and in the Independence of the United States of
America the thirtieth
