Therefore Calling to Mind the Mortality Of My body and Knowing, That it is Appointed for all Men once to die. do make and ordain This My last Will and Testament That is to say Principally and first of all. I give and Recommend My soul unto the hands of Almighty. God. who gave it and My body. I. Recommend. to The Earth to be buried in a Decent Christian Manner. at the Direction of My Executors. Hereafter Mentioned. Nothing doubting. but at the General. Resurrection. I shall. Receive. The same again by the Mighty power of God. and. Touching Such worldly Estate wich it hath pleased. God. to blefs me with in this life., I give demise and dispose in the following manner and Form - First it is My Will and Desire That all My Just debts be first paid out of My Estate.

Item.- I give and bequeath unto My Nephew.. Isaac. Bagnal. Jun. The son of my brother. John Bagnal. The Following property Six Negros Nam'd as .following - Biah Esick Cuff. Dick. Dolly. and Luc and all Their future Increase. with all my Lands. My House Household and Kitchen. Furniture. Plantation tools. Wagon, Cotton, Gin. and Six. Cows and Calves. the pick of my stock . The Cows and Calves to be for the Entire use of the Negros on the Plantation. with as. . Much of My Corn as will serve Them one year after My Decease. - but be it understoud, That the above named property. is not to be given up to the Above named. Isaac Bagnal untill he is Twenty one years. of age. to him and his Heirs forever -

Item.. I give and bequeath to My Grand Nephew.. Isaac Brogdon one Negro. boy Named, London, to him and his Heirs for Ever -

Item.. I give and bequeath to My Grand Nephew.. Isaac Brogdon one Negro. boy Named, London, to him and his Heirs for Ever -

Item. I give and bequeath to My Grand Nephew. Josiah. Isaac M. Gome<sup>c</sup> one Negro. Fellow. Nam'd , Minus, to him and his Heirs. for Ever -

It is My will and desire that the Remaining part of My Stock of Cattle Horses. Hogs. My Crop of Cotton and the Remaining part of My Corn be sold and Divided share and share alike. between My Two Deceased Sisters. Children,, Rebecca. Martin & Nancy Raffield and My living Sister, Children Mary Tobias. to them and Their Heirs -  
Lastly. I Nominate and Appoint. W., Plowden.. Samuel. E. Nelson.
