Imprimis I will and bequeath that my Body be Buried in Christian & like manner at the descretion of my Executors to be hereafter named, and that all of my Just debts be paid out of the proceeds of my Estate

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Tully Groomes all of my Property that I may p^{ossess} at the time of my death

Lastley in order to carry this my last will and testament into full and due ~~ex~~ercution thereof I do hereby appoint my True and trusty friend Thomas Boshers as Executors to this my last will & Testament, In witness whereof I here unto set my hand and Seal this 22nd day of Nov^r 1817
