In the name of the holy Trinity Amen
I, Isaac Whitworth of the District of Sumter do make, and ordain
the following the following Instrument of writing my last will
and Testament first I give and recommend my Soul to God. My Body
to be decently Buried my worldly Estate to be divided as follows
to wit. My funeral Charges and all my lawful debts to be paid in
a convenient Time after my Death- Item I give and bequeath unto
my wife Mary the one third of all of real and personal Estate her
Life time And also it is my wish that all of the personal property
that I leave unto my wife shall remain in the District her life
time and after her Death for all of the property both real and
personal to return to my Son Isaac and in Case that he should be
dead and has no living Issue for it to return to my Sisters
Item I give and Bequeath unto my Son Isaac all of the remainder
of my Estate both real and personal and if in Case he Dies before
he Marries or Arrives to the Age of Twenty One it is my wish for
it to go to my Sisters And that my Son Isaac is to Injoy his Share
of my Estate when he Marries or arrives to the Age of Twenty One
Years

And I do authorize my Executors to call in any Three neighbouring
Disinterested freeholders to make the Division aforesaid
I appoint William Anderson John Shaw and Samuel Witherpoon my
whole and Sole Executors of this my last will and Testament confir-
ming this to be my last will disannulling all others former Wills
and Testaments by me hereby made.
