I James Spann, Senior, of Sumter District and State aforesaid, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament-----

I give to my Son William a negro woman called Danna which I have heretofore loaned to him

I give to my Son Tyre a negro woman called Delina, which I have heretofore loaned to him

I give to my daughter Heriot wife of Walker Watson a negro girl called Darky, which I have heretofore loaned to her-----

And I give to my daughter Anna wife of Dr Yates a negro woman named Suckey which I have heretofore loaned to her-----

I give to my son Charles a prime negro woman or the value thereof as my Executors may think best, whenever he may think proper to call upon them for the same-----

As I have already given to my two Eldest Sons William and Tyre, Each, a horse worth One hundred and fifty Dollars, I wish my son Charles to have one of equal value and also Each of my two youngest Sons Lawrence and Timothy as they shall arrive at age.

The rest of my Estate real and personal I wish kept together for the support and maintenance of my wife Anna and the support, maintenance and Education of my three youngest children Lawrence Timothy and Maria and as these three children severally marry or arrive at age I wish them each to have a negro equal in value to a prime young woman-- the valuation to be established by my Executors-----

After my three youngest Children shall have been educated and provided for as before directed I give the balance and residue of my Estate real and personal to my wife Anna for and during her natural life and at her death I wish the Same Equally divided

After my three youngest Children shall have been educated and provided for as before directed I give the balance and residue of my Estate real and personal to my wife Anna for and during her natural life and at her death I wish the Same Equally divided between my Children-----

All the Estate real and personal given or intended to be given hereafter by this will I wish held in Trust by Tyre Jennings and James G Spann So that the portions or shares allotted to my Sons shall not be subject to their disposal or liable for their debts; And the portions or shares allotted to my daughters shall not be

subject to their disposal or liable for their own debts or the debts of ^{their} ~~thir~~ present or any future husbands

Should any of my Children die and not ^{leave} have a Child or Children who shall marry or attain the age of twenty one years all the Estate real and personal given them by this will, I wish equally divided between my surviving Children-----

I do hereby nominate and appoint Tyre Jennings and James G. Spann my Executors

I witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and Seal, this nineteenth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Twenty Seven-----

Codocil- It is my will and desire that my two Sons Lawrence and Timothy have in stead of the negro woman given to each of them of the value of four hundred Dollars the following negro woman and their Children to be equally divided between them (that is to say) Anaky and her three Children Will, Lozetta and Willis: And Vilet and her three Children called Lewis, Thadius and Alfred-

It is also my will and desire that my daughter Maria instead of the negro woman given to her the value of four hundred dollars the following negroes to wit Hannah and Edwin together with her increase.
