I bequeath as follows Viz/ I give to agnes Roberts my beloved Daughter, the sum of Fifty dollars, I give to my Grand Daughter Janet Douglass, the sum of Fifty Dollars, (also) my bed & furniture with your leave I give to my Grand son James Gordon Montgomery the sum of Twenty five Dollars, I give to my beloved Daughter Margaret Dow Hancock the sum of Ten Dollars, I give to my beloved Charles Barr the sum of Five Dollars, all out of the above hire, To my beloved son John Barr I give whatsoever ballance of Tonys hire is due at this expiration of the year I give Ten Dollars to my Grand Daughter Sarah Roberts to be made up out of the said rent.-I am your most affectionate
