I Jane Tisdale of the State of South Carolina in the District of Sumter and County of Claremont, Widow, being weak in body but of sound mind and memory blefised be God for the same, do make and, declare this my last will and Testament, in manner and form followong: I give devise and bequeath unto my Son Francis Tisdale fifty dollars; Secondly. I give devise and bequeath unto My Sons John Tisdale and Sherwood Tisdale Share and Share alike, all the rest of my goods and Chattels and resedue and remainder of my Estate and effects of whatever nature or kind seever. And I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint, My Son John Tisdale, and My son Sherwood Tisdale and James Caldwell My Executors of this my last will and testament, In witnefs whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this twenty fifth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen
