First I give & Bequeath to Jacob Manning my Grand son Six Cows & seventeen stock or Dry Cattle marked with an upper figure of seven in one ear & a Crop & under bit in the other & nine sheep with the increase of the same till they come in his possession with my bed & bedding also one Hundred Acres of Land whereon I now live the Land he shall not dispose of in Joseph M. Mans life time-----

I likewise Constitue ~~make~~ & ordain Stephen Savins & Arthior White sole Executors of this my last will & Testament & I do hereby ^{attest} revoke disallow & Disannul all & every other will Testament Legacies Bequests and Executors Ratifying this & no other to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this the tenth of January one thousand Seven hundred & ninety one---
