Item I give and bequeath to my Son inlaw-Joseph Way, one negro named Judy & her Children which S. Item It is my Will and pleasure that all my Estate of what kind soever, not already disposed, and particularly mentioned in the above bequests, be equally divided, between my Son James Armstrong, my Son inlaw Moses Gordon, my Son inlaw James Anderson and my Son inlaw David Frierson to them and their Heirs forever Item I do hereby nominate, Ordain, Constitute and appoint, my three Sons in law (Viz) Moses Gordon. James Anderson and David Frierson Executors of this my last Will and Testament, renouncing and disanulling, all all former or other Will, or wills. and rattifying and confirming, this and this only to be my last Will and Testament, in witnefad whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this twenty third day of May in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and six, and thirtseth Year of the Independence of the United States of North America ---Signed Sealed published and ) James Armstrong (SEAL) declared in presence of
