I give and bequeath to my sor Marmaduke Atkinson one Megro man slave named Ned - I give and bequeath to my con hadrick thin: one negro man slave neged till end one Negro oman slave næged ris. and the increase of her Boody, the said Negroes he now has in pofsefsion - I give and bequeath to my son Fedrick 't inson one Negro man Slave nemed Simon the said negro he has now in per sefsion - I give and bequeath to my son Adwill Atginson and man slave named Isaac and one negro boy lave named Joe and one Negro gairl Slave named lucy and bed and furniture new in his per sefsion - I give and bequeath to the Heirs of my Daughter Martin Lenior deceased one negro woman slave named Sarah and the increased of her body which Said negro, now have in persension - I give and bequeath to my Daughter Lucy Crofswell and the Heairs of her Lody one negro woman slave and her increase forever which said Megro

they now have inpossession and her name is tall - I give and be queath to my Drughter Elezabeth County Wills
