I. James McEathern resident of Sumpter district State of South Carolina, do hereby make my last will & testament .---It is my wish & desire that my Uncle Duncan McNeill of roberson c unty State of North Carolina, should after my discease collect all my accounts notes &C. and pay out of them, whatever debts should appear against my estate. Should the accounts notes of which I may have against -- any person or persons be mow when collected than will pay my Just debts, I desire that the overplus of the money, should be equally devided among my wife & three children: but should the money arising from my accts, notes &C when collected not be enough to discharge my lawful debts, It is my wish that such a part of my other property as my Uncle Dundan cNeill shall judge best bank be sold & appropriated to that use. hatever property there shall be remaining after all my debts are padd. It is my wish that the same should be appraised & equally distributed among my family viz my wife & three children, It is my desire that my wife should have as a part of my estate that my fall to her share my Negro woman Kinia. Should the negro woman on valuation, he found to be more than the proportion of my estate that may fall to her-chare, when equally divided between herself & three children, my wife is to make up the deficiency on the part of the children, so that they all pofsefs an equal part. It is my wish & desire that my wife should pofsefs the Negro woman Linia & whatever other property may fall to her share. during her natural life". but at her discease. the negro woman Linia her increase & whatever other property she may have as her equal share of my estate should return to my children and be equally divided among them. I appoint my Uncle Duncan McNeill my executor. withers my hand and Seal, this Manch day of August the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & fifteen.
