Unter District and State aforesaid being in a low & poor health
but of sound mind and memory, and knowing that all men have to die,
do make and ordain this my last will and Testament--that is to say--
First I recommend my soul to almighty god who gave it and my body
to burued in a Decent and Christian like manner by my Executors--
and as to what property it has pleas'd god to blefs me with, (after
the payment of my Just Debts) give and dispose of in Manner fol-
lowing. Miz. Item I give and bequeath unto my two Children Matt-^w
Fort and Amanda Fort (Also Children of Mrs Mary Fort) dec^d,) all
my Estate both real and personall of whatever kind soever, also
my stock of Cattle, Horses, and Hogs and all my Household and
Kitchen Furniture with all Money and debts due to me whatsoever,
to them and their Child or Children surviving the age of twenty one
years, or Marriage, and in case either shall die without a child or
Children as above, then his or her part her eby given to return to
the living heirs of my Family--to be equally divided among them
and do hereby appoint appoint John Ramsey and Willis Ramsey my
two Brothers and also Robt^t Moore my Lawful Executors-----
In Witnes I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 24th Dur
1812
