In the Name of God amen I James Rembert of the State of S^c Carolina
 Quarter district (Planter) being of Sound & perfect mind, Memory
 and understanding, thanks be to god for the Same. DO make this my
 last will & testament in form & manner following: Imprimis, in the
 name and thro' the great merits of Jesus Christ my Lord and only
 Savior I do commend my Soul to the mercies of a gracious God in
 full hopes of a glorious immortallity & my body I commend to the
 earth to be decently interred at the discretion of my Executors here-
 after named & as for such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased
 God to blesse me with I do give & bequeath the same as follows, First
 I give wholly for the use of the Methodist Society in this neighbor-
 hood the meeting house^{se} on homeswamp together with two acres of Land
 around the Same. Item I lend to my beloved wife Ann Rembert the
 following property Viz Six Negroes named Jack, Baby, Isaac, New
 Jacob, New Silvy & Daniel She to clothe them ^{pay} & their taxes also
 Six cows & calves one three year old Steer one two year old D^o one
 fourth part of my hogs, all my Sheep, two of my horses Such as She
 shall choose, also one third part of my household furniture, after
 the appraisment take place the value of the whole of the furniture
 to be ascertained she then to choose whatever may suit her best to
 the amount of one third part of the whole. she is also to have
 use of of the house & out houses where I now live (the gin & gin
 house Excepted) & the free undisturbed use of all the cleared Land
 included in the Rearery in Which the house is Situated together with
 the privilege of firewood & timber the above property to be freely
 used by her during the time she remains my widow, & in case she
 never marries during her life, the whole of which shall immediatly
 after her marriage or death revert to my children hereafter to be
 named or their heirs. Item I give & bequeath to my sons Samuel, Caleb

Item. I give & bequeath to my Son Caleb a tract of land containing

acres more or less granted to Jn^o Rembert being part of a tract of

old Frank, Tom, Phillis, Tomay, Nancy Lucy long Silvy little Lyddy,
Sally, Lukey, Borttin, Bet Mary, little Frank Hannah, Ben little Jo
big Jacob, Stephen, Leah, Nan, little Amy, little little Nero, &
1 Ben old Jafsemin, Josey, Caty to him his heirs & assigns forever.
Item I give & bequeath to my son Isaac the Plantation whereon I now

to Jn^o Chamber also two other tract one of an hundred acres granted
to Mary Shepperd the other of thirty acres granted to Sam^l Rembert,
also one other tract containing three hundred acres granted to Jn^o
Fleming also Seven hundred & fifty acres more or less being part
of a tract containing of three thousand acres granted to Jn^o Rutledge

Milly, Mino, Little Nero, Short Silvy Duck, Cloe little Silvy, Ned,

to him his heirs & assigns forever. & my will is that in case my

Item I give & bequeath to my son Isaac the Plantation whereon I now

five more or less being part of a tract granted to Sam^l Dwyer & by
him conveyed to me, also a tract of one hundred & ten acres granted
to Jn^o Chamber also two other tract one of an hundred acres granted

I give & bequeath to my Grand Son James Rembert Dubose one Negro
girl named Grace, to his his heirs & assigns forever. the rest
residue & remainder of my Estate after my just debts are first paid
I give to be Equally divided between my children above named or
their heirs in the manner following Viz let my acting Executors or
Executors hereafter to be named choose three respectable Neighbor
& let them make as many divisions or lots as there shall be heirs
& let a lot be drawn for Each heir, all of them to take possession

Immediately my Son Isaac excepted his portion to remain as above directed. And I do hereby nominate ordain & appoint my Son Caleb Rembert & Doct^r Ezekiel Dubose Executors of this my last Will and testament & I do hereby revoke & make Void all former & other wills by Me at any time heretofore Made & I do publish & declare these presents to be & contain my only last will & testament in witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal this Seventeenth day of Sept^r in the year of Our Lord One thousand Eight hundred & Ten
