State of South Carolina In the name of God Amen I Jefse Wilder of Sumter Destrict and State aforesaid being infirm in Body but of Sound and disposing mind and Memory and calling to mind the mortality of the Body and the immortality of the Soul do make and ordain this my Last will and testament hereby revoking all and every other will made by me or for my use whatsoever-----

Imprimus I lend to my beloved wife Mary all my property whatsoever during her widowhood (as my widow) for the maintenance of her self and my Children who are to continue with her and be equally supported out of the property during the above term and if my beloved wife Mary should Marry again i Will and desire that my property shall be ^{at the} discrefsion of my Executors to be hereafter named, and that she then be placed on the same footing with each one of my Children viz that she shall have her proportionable part of whatever is made by my Estate but that there may be no divifion of my property nowwilled in her favour and after her death that the property be equally divided among my Children-----p-----

Item I will that my just Debts be paid out of the proceeds of my Estate and I do hereby nominate and appoint my friends Thomas N. Johnfon and John^r Boyd Jun^r my Executors to this my last will and Testament made this 23rd December one thoufand eight hundred and one-----
