3^d I give and bequeath to my son Edward Cannon all my carpenters
tools and grind Stones-----

4th I give and bequeath to my son Nathaniel Cannon one bay hair--
And lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my wife Jumima My
executrix to this my last will and Testament revoking and annullin
all former will or wills which I may ^{have} heretofore made and Executed
in Witnefs whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 27th
day of september and in the Year of our Lord one thousand Eight
hundred and seven-----
