JOHN CANNON

In the name of God Amen,

John Cannon of Sumter County, State of South Carolina,
do make and constitute this my last will and Testament
following to wit -

1st I desire that all my just debts shall be first paid off and discharged as soon after my death as can conveniently be done---

2^d I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Jumima four cows and three Yearlings and one calf all my beds and furniture belonging to them all my Household and Kitchen furniture also My plantation tools waggon and gear also my whole stock of Hogs

3^d I give and bequeath to my son Edward Cannon all my carpenters tools and grind Stone-----

4th I give and bequeath to my son Nathaniel Cannon one bay hair- And lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my wife Jumima My executrix to this my last will and Testament revoking and annulling all former will or wills which I may heretofore made and Executed in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 27th day of September and in the Year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and seven-----
