I John Christmus of State and District afforesaid Being very Sick and weak in body But of perfect mind and Memory thanks be to God and Calling unto mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die I Make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say principally and first of all I give and Recommend my Soul into the hands of Almyty god that gave it and as tuching Such ~~my~~ worldly Estate where with it has pless god to biefs me in this life I give dismifs and dispose of the same in the following manner and form ~~first~~ I give the plantation of two hundred acres of land that I now live on with all the housel furniture and all plantation tools belonging there unto to my beloved wife Nancy Christmus I further leave my Son Nathan Christmus and my Son Absolon Christmus I make and ordain them the Sole Ececutors of this my last will and testement also I leave one Bay mare and one back hors to my wife nancy and four Cows and Calve I leave to my wife also one two year old heffer I leave to my granddaughter Nancy Arons daughter also I leave to wife two sows and pgs and eight year old and ten year old hogs and eight ^{two} near or sheep and all the gees and all the Remaining part of all my stock of every kind I leave to my five sons Aron Mofses & Nathen Absolan and Ephrem to Be equelly devided and one Negro Boy named Rees I give to my son Ephrem the waggon I leave to use of the plantation and all the family But all pay a part in hepear of her this givin under my hand and Seal this twenty Second day of Octobe one thousand Eight hundred and ten and in the 34-a.d 35 year of american indepondanc and in the presents of thies witefs
