In the name of God amen, I John Greening of Sumter District and State of South Carolina planter, being in perfect health, mind, memory, thanks be to God, do make & ordain this my last will & testament, wrote with my own, hand in manner & form following Viz I do will & bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Greening the following three negroes Sarah her Son July & daughter Nelly & a horse and chair Bed and furniture.

to her & her heirs and afsigns for Ever;-----

Item I will and bequeath unto my Sons as follows Wade Horace Greening, Bridger Geefson Greening and John James Greening, when either Marries or arrives to age of twenty one years old three negroes between the age of twelve and twenty years. good Horse a d Saddle, three cows & calves, Bead and Furniture to each;

Item I will and bequeath unto my Son Rufus William Greening, four negroes between the age of twelve & twenty years old, two of which negroes I wish to boys and bound with him to what traide he may lik put at the age of seventeen, and be his at twenty one years old which will be the time of his freedom, good horse & saddle three cows & calves bead and furniture all to be delivered at the time he is twenty one Years Old or Marries;-----

Item I will and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Ann Greening when she Marries or arrives to age of eighteen years old, three negroes, between twelve and twenty Years old, a good horse three cows & calves bead and furniture;-----

Item I will and beq.eath unto my Daughter Mary Whitehead Greening when she arrives to the age of fifteen years old three Negroes between twelve and twenty years old, a good horse three cows & calves bead and furniture;-----

Item I will and Bequeath Unto my Daughter Anna Aoleen Greening

following three negroes Sarah her Son July & daughter Nelly &
one fair bed and furniture.

to her & her heirs and assigns for Ever;-----

Item I will and bequeath unto my Sons as follows Wade Horace Greening, Eldridge Sevefacon Greening and John James Greening, when either marries or arrives to age of twenty one years old three negroes between the age of twelve and twenty years. good Horse a d Saddle, three cows & calves, Bed and Furniture to each;

Item I will and bequeath unto my Son Rufus William Greening, four negroes between the age of twelve & twenty years old, two of which negroes I wish to boys and bound with him to what trade he may lik

but at the age of seventeen, and be his at twenty one years old which will be the time of his freedom, good horse & saddle three cows & calves bed and furniture all to be delivered at the time he is twenty one Years Old or Marries;-----

Item I will and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Ann Greening when she Marries or arrives to age of eighteen years old, three negroes, between twelve and twenty Years old, a good horse three cows & calves bed and furniture;-----

Item I will and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Whitehead Greening when she arrives to the age of fifteen years old three Negroes between twelve and twenty years old, a good horse three cows & calves bed and furniture;-----

Item I will and Bequeath Unto my Daughter Amanda Cleen Greening three Negroes between the age of twelve and twenty years old, horse, three cows & calves, Bed & furniture;-----

Item It is my will & desire that in case my wife should be Pregnant at the time of my death, that the child shall share equal, with Wade, Eldridge, John, Elizabeth Mary and Amanda Greening both of real and personal property;-----

Item it is my will that all my lands in this state be sold for the purpose of Paying my Debts, and that a tract at the Discussion of

my executors be Bought for the use of my Family, until and work
my Servants in untill my Daughter Mary Whitehead Greening becomes
fifteen years Old, then those that have received there Legacy as
above named to Recive it, and the remainder to be equally divided,
I will set my Children with out a sail of the Personal property,
Item should my wife Marry, it is my will that she receive Sarah
the Bell horse and Chair lead and Furniture in lew of Dowery--
Item it is my desire that should my executors after selling my Lands
find it actually necessary to dispose of more property for the pur-
pose of paying my Just Debts that they sell Master a Blacksmith,
John Hob & wife Abigail

Item my will is that my property be kept be Kept to gether for the
supporting of my family and educating my Children, untill any may
die then they may Receive there Legacy and have no farther support
from the state untill the final Division when all the land must be
paid and Divided amongst my Children Equall.

Lastly I do will ordain and Constitute my beloved wife Mary Greening
Bectrix During her Incowhood, Wade H Greening, and Clark Taylor
of Georgia my Lawful Executors, of this my last will and testament;
In witness where unto I set my hand and seal this the Seventh Day
of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
fifties;
