will & Testament. first I give and Recommend my soul to god all-mighty that first give me Existence - & my Body to the Earth in Decent Christian Burial - at the Discretion of my Executor. and as touching such worldly Estate as it has pleased god to Bless me with in this Life I give & Dispose of in the following form & manner - Viz -first I give & Bequath to my Beloved wife Susanah Two Negroes for her Life time viz - Sam & Jeney - together with my household furniture & plantation tools-. & the Lands to me belonging - which said Negroes. Lands furniture &c. after her death is to then go to my Son James for his part. & it is my Desire that James Do Se to & take Care of his mother while She Lives: & he is to take Charge and Se to the Settlement of a Bond. or Debt in Ch-ton - Secondly I give & Bequeath to my Daughter Susanah a Negroe Named Prince.- thirdly I give & Bequeath to My Daughter agnefs one Negroe Named Bob - fourthly I give & Bequath to my son William one Negroe Named Abram - fifthly I give & Bequath to my Daughter

Harriot Two Negroes - pheoby & Mary- & as for Mary Spears & John Holladay Jun. I give and Bequeath three Dollars to Be Equally Divided Between them - Viz it is my will & Desire that Bob left to my Daughter agnefs shall go to her Daughter Elizabeth Chester - who she Maries - & I Do hereby Constitute & appoint my son James Holladay to be the whole & sole Executor of this my Last will & Testament - in witnefs whereof I set my hand & seal this-12. of September - 1812
