I John Lenoir Sen^r of Hunter District in the State of South Carolina of perfect Mind and Memory, thanks be to God for it. but calling to Mind that it is appointed for all men, once to die, do Make and ordain this my last will and Testament, in the Manner and form following. Viz. I recomend My Soul to God ~~that-it~~ & My body to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretions of My Executors, hereafter Mentioned, It^m I desire that my part of the cotton crop When geathered, to be Sold, & the Money to pay to those Who I am indebted to. Itm. I desire that My wife Should keep a Negroe Wench Named Beck, & likewise all the Movable property during her Natural Life. Itm. And at her death, I desire that all My real & personal property be Sold at twelve Months credit. & the Money equally divided between her Nine Children. Itm. the above Named wench Shall have the privilege of choosing her own Master. Itm. And my wife Shall keep a Negroes girl Named Judy, during her--Natural life. Itm. I desire that Israel G. Mathis Shall have his lawful fee for every Just he gains for my Estate. It . I desire that Abram Blanding Sinclair Linbacker,
