I John Perry of South Carolina Sumter District, being weak and frail in body but of sound mind memory and understanding recollecting the uncertainty of life and the certainty of Death, and feeling desirous before my decease to dispose of such worldly property with which it has pleased God, to blefs me with, I do therefore mak and constitute this and no other to be my last Will and Testament as follows -----

Imprimus, I will and desire that all my lawful debts be paid -

Item I will and desire that my property both real and Personal be equally divided between my three Children (Viz) Sarah-Anngulina Perry, Samuel James Bradley Perry, and Ollave Hazzard Perry.-

Item I will and desire my Estate be kept together until eldest Child Comes of age ~~or~~ marries then in that Case my Executors shall ^{without applying to Court} nominate five disinterested freeholders, to appraise the whole of my Estate and set off ^{to} the their Heir that it of Age or married its share, and the remainder to be kept together untill the Second Heir Comes of Age or marries then my Executors shall again procede as above, and in Case either of my Children should die before they Comes of Age or marries my Executors shall again divide the Deceased part as above -

Lastly, I Constitute, Nominate, and appoint, William W. Bradley and William Wilson my Executors of this my last will and testament, and I do hearby revoke all former wills and acknowledge this and this only to be my last will and testament in witnefs whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 6th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred twenty two and in the forty Seventh Year of American Independance -
