JOHN PETTYPOOL

In The Name of God Amen,-----

I John Pettypool of Sumter District in the State of South Carolina

Being very Sick and weak in Body, but Strong in mind and memory,  
thanks be to god for the Same--and Calling to mind the mortality  
of man, and knowing <sup>that</sup> it is appointed for all men to die, do make  
and ordain this my last will and Testament--That is to Say after  
my departure of this life I desire to be buried in a decent manner  
at the discretion of my Executors,---Secondly I desire that all  
my Just debts shall be paid, after which I give Devise and dispose  
of the Same in manner and form following,-----

In the first place I lend to Ann Pettypool my dearly beloved wife,  
that Plantation or tract of land I now live on Containing one hun-  
dred and forty eight acres, together with all my Personal Estate  
during her life, Secondly at her death, I Give and bequeath to my  
two Children VIZ, Stephen Pettypool and Ellen Pettypool lawful heirs  
of my Body, all that Estate above mentioned both real and personal  
for Ever, to be eaquelly devided between the two--And I do like wise  
Constitute make and ordain Spencer Wilder and Ann Pettypool my only  
and Sole Executors of this my last will and Testament, and I do here  
by utterly disallow Revoke and Disannul all and Every other former  
Testaments wills and Legacies Bequests and Executors, by me in any  
ways before this time named, Willad and Bequeathed Ratifying and  
Confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament,-----
