I John Rafield being of perfect mind & memory make this my last Will & testament-- first I Desire to Be Decently Buried at the Discretion of any Executors--& as touching such worldly Estate as it has pleased God to Bleſs me with in this Life--I give and Dispose of in form and manner following first it is my Desire that all my Lawfull Debts be paid- Item-I give and Bequeath to my Brother William Rafield all the Land that is Due and Coming to me from my fathers Estate--also all the tools stock of Cattle hogs goats plantation and household furniture and one Negro man Named prince--together with my Bed & furniture and all my wearing apparel and my horse and gun and whatever money I may have or may Be Due to me at the time of my Deceas-- Item I give and Bequeath to my sister Jean Dukes ten pounds Item I give and Bequeath to my sister Isabella Dukes-one pound Item I give and Bequeath to my sister Elisabeth Rafield one pound and I Do hereby Constitute and appoint my Brother William Rafield and John Ridgill Esq<sup>r</sup> to Be the Executors of this my Last will and testament-Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to Be my Last Will and Testament-----
