Item I give and Bequeath to my sister Isabella Dukes-one pound

Item I give and Bequeath to my sister Elisabeth Rafield one pound

and I Do hereby Constitute and appoint my Brother William

Rafield and John Ridgill Esq^r to Be the Executors of this my

Last will and testament-Ratifying and Confirming this and no

other to Be my Last Will and Testament-----
