

I John White of the State and District aforesaid being in a weak and low State of body, but of sound mind and memory and calling to mind the mortality of my nature, Do order and dispose of the worldly property where with God hath blefsted me in the form and manner following. Viz;

Item,-----Do will & bequath to my beloved wife Dovey, The use ~~And~~ of my house and plantation During her widowhood; and after her marriage to be confined to her thirds of said plantation--I further bequeath to my said wife the following slaves viz old Jinny Jack, Easter, Jacob and Elizap--also the whole of my household and Kitchen furniture, & plantation tools, with two cows and calve and my sorrel horse, as her full part of my Estate-----

Item, I will and bequeath the remainder of my real and personal Estate to my son John Kinsey;- but in case my wife should have ifssue by me after this; then my real & personal Estate to be equally divided between them--; and in case of the death of either, then the surviving Child to inherit the whole of my Estate and further provided, in case of the death of all all my ifssue, then my beloved wife to have the whole of my real estate, and half of the personal property, during her lifetime And in that case; then it is my will that my real Estate go to Eli Fleming my half Brother, and the whole of my personal property to be divided, the one half, equally between my half Brother Josiah Fleming, and my half sisters Mary & Harriot Fleming--and the other half to be divided so that one half thereof shall go to the children of my sister Ann and the other half to the child or children of my sister Elizabeth. Item I do hereby pronounce & declare this to be my last will & testa. ent made in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & fourteen and of the Independence of the United States of America the thirty ninth; September the twenty first
