

LEWIS McCLENDON

In the Name of God Amen. I Lewis McLendon do make this my last Will,
and Testament as follows Viz.

First I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Susa Dunn McClendon, the ^{whole} ~~part~~ of all my estate both real, and personal, during the time of her widowhood; in lieu of her dowry: but in case she should marry it is my will and desire that she receive an ^{equal} part of my personal estate, with my children, during her natural life only; and at the time of her death to return to my children, to be divided in the manner herein directed.-----

I give and bequeath to my son Calvin McClendon the Land, and Plantation whereon I now live, after the death or marriage of my wife Susa Dunn McClendon-----

It is likewise my will and desire that at the death of my wife Susa Dunn M'Clendon; that my children Jacob M'Clendon, Mary Mieson, Sarah M'Clendon, Laney M'Clendon, Parity Robinson, & Calvin M'Clendon, do have the lone of all my personal estate share, and share alike, during their natural lives: and at the death of either of the above children it is my will, and desire, that the part above mentioned do go to the issue of their own body; and if no such issue, then such part to return to the surviving part of my Children; but in case any of my children should be dead having left issue, that such issue do receive the part, which their parent would have been entitled to, in case he, or she had been living. And I do hereby constitute and ordain Susa Dunn M'Clendon Jacob M'Clendon and Calvin M'Clendon Executors to this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this fifth day of May in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and seventeen and in the forty first year of the Independence of America-----
