In the Name of God Amen. I Lewis McLendon do make this my last Will,
and Testament as follows Viz.

tion whereon I now live, after the death or marriage of my wife Susa

It is likewise my will and desire that at the death of my wife Susa
Dunn M'Clendon; that my children Jacob M'Clendon, Mary Mieson, Sarah
M'Clendon, Laney M'Clendon, Parity Robinson, & Calvin M'Clendon, do
have the lone of all my personal estate share, and share alike, du-
ring their natural lives: and at the death of either of the above
Children it is my will, and desire, that the part above mentioned
do go to the issue of their own body; and if no such issue, then
such part to return to the surviving part of my Children; but in
case any of my children should be dead having left issue, that such
issue do receive the part, which their parent would have been entitled
to, in case he, or she had been living. And I do hereby constitute
make and ordain Susa Dunn McLendon Jacob M'Clendon and Calvin M'Clen-
