Lidia Christmas of Sumter District and State of South Carolina ~~Writing~~ Calling to mind the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death do make this my last will and testament---I - I. commend my soul to God that gave it and my body to be buried in a decent Christian manner--and as to my worldly goods &c I make the following distribution--Item 1<sup>st</sup> I give unto my niece Lidia Copland my bed & furniture my trunk and one heifer yearlin-Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I. give unto my niece Lottisa Daniels a the young cow beast running at Hopkins Daniels--Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I. give unto my Sister Mary Daniels one Seventy dollars, and one half of my wearing apparel---Item 4<sup>th</sup> I. give unto my Sister Nancy Copland the other half of my wearing apparel and also all the residue of my Estate after paying my Just debts--6<sup>thly</sup> & last I. nominate and appoint my friend Alfred Scarborough Executor to this my last will & testament-----In Witness I. hereunto Set my hand & Seal this 1<sup>st</sup> day of November A.D. 1839)
