Firft, I humbly bequeath my Soul to God, my Maker: befeeching his moft Gracious Acceptance of it, thro', the all sufficient, Merits & mediation of my moft Compafionate Redeemer, Jefus Christ Who gave himſelf to be an Attonement for my Sins, And is Able to save to the Uttermoſt all that come unto God by him; ſeing he ever liveth to make Interceſion for them, And who, I doubt not, will receive me A returning Penitent Sinner, When I come to him for Mercy. In this hope and Confidence, I render up my Soul with Comfort befeeching the Moft Glorious Trinity: one God, moft Holy, moft Merciful, and Gracious, to prepare me for the time of my Difolution: And then to take me to himſelf into that peace And reſt And incomparabla Felicity, which he has prepared for all that fear And love him, Amen. Bleſſed be God, I give my Body to the Earth, from whence it was taken; in full Aſſurance of its Refurection from thence at the laſt Day.---As for my Burial, I leave entirely at the Difcretion of my executors, hereafter Named who I doubt not, will Mange it with all Requifite prudence: As to my Worldly Affects, I will and poſitively order that all my Debts be paid.---

And Fifteen Dollars to be paid to him Every year from my Decease During his Natural lifetime, for his ſupport to be paid out of the Ac- cumulations of my property (Tho Divided.)

Item I give & bequeath Unto my beloved Son William Carter one
Negro Boy Namd Jimmy alſo one Bed & furniture all Houſehold,
Kitchen, Table, And Deary Furniture.---

Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Margaret Alexander.
one Bed & furniture together with one hair Trunk and all my Wearing

Item, I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Susannah Story
One hundred and Fifty Dollars, to be paid to her one year After my
decease-----

Item, I give & bequeath the remainder of my Estate to be Equally
Divided between my beloved Children---Say, Daniel Carter, William
Carter, And Margaret Alexander And if the Said Daniel or William
Carter or Margaret Alexander or Either of the Them Should Die
without
Heirs, the property to return Equally to the Surviving heirs of
Daniel or William Carter, or Margaret Alexander----- -----

Also, I conftitute, make & Appoint, William Carter & Daniel Carter
the executors of this my laft will & Teftament, And I do hereby
Utterly Difallow, revok & Difannul, all & every other former
Teftament, Wills, Legacies, bequeaths & executors by me in any
wise before Named willed & bequeathed; ratifying & confirming this
& no other to be my laft will & Teftament In Witneſs whereof I have
hereunto Set my hand & Seal this Twenty fifſt Day of January In
the year of Our Lord, One thouſand Eight Hundred & One, & the 25th
year of American Independence
