Inprimise my will and desire is that my Bed. and Furniture And Trunks and my weaving apparel to be left to the disposal of my beloved Mother Sarah Pendergrafs my will and Desire Likewise is that my Servant Isaac should be left with My my beloved Mother above named during the minority of My Beloved Son John James Pendergrafs Conyers and in case Of the Death off my said Son above named before he arrives to The years of twenty one I then leave the said Servant Isaac to My beloved Mother Mother forever, my horse I leave to my beloved Father Sam<sup>l</sup> Pendergrafs my Riding Chair I leave to my Brother Sam<sup>l</sup> Pendergrafs Under my Brother Benj<sup>n</sup> Roberts Pendergrafs I leave three Hundred Dollars To my Sister Amelia Almira Pendergrafs I leave three Hundred Dollars to my Sister Cecilia Warburton Pendergrafs I leave three Hundred Dollars----To my Sister Sarah Ann Pendergrafs I leave one Hundred.----Dollars My small Library I wish to be kept for the use of my Son the remainder of my Estate I leave and bequeath to My beloved Son John James Pendergrafs Conyers and in Case of the Death of my said son above Named before he should arrive to the age of Twenty one years I then leave my estate to my Brothers and Sisters and to the Surviving Children of My Husband John Conyers to be Equally divided between Them Share and Share alike and I request of my Executors That he should hire out my Negroes to the best advantage And the moneys arising there from to discharge the Legacy Before mentioned in this my will

Lastly I do hereby--Nominate Constitute and appoint My beloved Father Executor to this my last will and Testament In Witnesses where of I have hereunto Set my hand And Seal this second day of october.
